The 2018 Neighbourhood Support New Zealand Awards (NSNZ) is an opportunity for us to come together as an organisation to recognise and celebrate the invaluable support and outcomes that our members, volunteers, and partners have contributed to NSNZ and our local communities over the past year.

As a mostly volunteer run organisation, it takes thousands of individuals, schools, businesses, and groups to help us achieve our vision of creating safer, resilient and more connected communities. RULES + REGULATIONS

In order to participate, all nominators must be part of a registered NSNZ Member Organisation and be at least 18 years old at the time of completing a nomination. Nominators are welcome to make multiple nominations and must ensure that the reason for nomination only includes an individual, partner, or project involved with NSNZ during the 1st July 2017 - 30th June 2018 calendar year.

By completing a nomination, being nominated, or receiving an award, you consent to have your photo and/or award and nomination information used by NSNZ in internal and external marketing and communications including social media, media releases, email newsletters, and other publicity including that generated by our partners, other NSNZ Member Organisations, and third-party media.

- Nominations are open from 9am Thursday 23 August 2018
- Nominations close at 5pm on Sunday 30 September 2018

CATEGORIES

The following categories have been specially created to help us recognise outstanding works and efforts from our members, volunteers, and partners who help make Neighbourhood Support New Zealand the amazing network and resource that it is.

We are looking for nominations that reflect innovation and enthusiasm for achieving one or more of the following criteria:

- Dedication to promoting and / or improving NSNZ and our Member Organisations in any capacity including funding, membership, profile, campaigns, and operations
- Positively impacting the community, other members, or neighbours through NSNZ
- Supporting our key areas of work - safer communities, resilient communities, and / or connected communities

When completing a nomination, please be sure to specify which category you would like to nominate for.

1. Co-ordinator of the Year

An Area Co-ordinator who currently works for a NSNZ Member Organisation either in a paid or voluntary capacity and consistently goes above and beyond the call of duty.

2. Volunteer of the Year

Someone currently volunteering for a NSNZ Member Organisation (i.e. street contact, committee member, etc.) who has provided outstanding service.

3. Project of the Year

A project run by a NSNZ Member Organisation which achieved a positive outcome.

4. Partner of the Year

An organisation (i.e. business, school, government agency, or other community organisation) who has worked effectively with a NSNZ Member Organisation.

5. Champion of the Year

An individual or group who has worked hard to promote and support the Neighbourhood Support message this year.
